This workshop is designed to provide information about children with sexual behavior problems and will provide a context for responding to both children and their families in a purposeful way. Emphasis will be placed on decreasing high risk behaviors, accessing parents and caretakers to provide careful supervision, and engaging children in treatment so that they can learn to identify and use their internal controls, regulate their affect, and understand their unique cues of impending problem behaviors. A variety of play-based assessment strategies will be provided along with specific expressive and CBT-based treatment strategies.

Instructor: Dr. Eliana Gil has worked for 35 years in child abuse prevention and treatment. She is Director of Clinical Services for Childhelp Children's Center in Fairfax, Virginia, a treatment program that utilizes an integrated approach to helping abused children and their families, providing individual, group, and family therapy. Dr. Gil is a Registered Play Therapy Supervisor, Registered Art Therapist, and a licensed Marriage, Family, Child Counselor, and she is a former President of the Association for Play Therapy. She has written numerous materials on child abuse and related topics and is the author of several books, including *Sexualized Children: Assessment and Treatment of Sexualized Children and Children Who Molest* (co-authored with Dr. Toni Cavanagh Johnson).
