APT Play-Therapy Specific (6 hr.)

Family Play Therapy is a modality that uses playful therapeutic techniques when engaging two or more family members. It allows the therapist to observe interactions, and it opens meaningful discussion with the family. This lively, hands-on class will focus primarily on how symbolic images can be combined with the use of simple, inexpensive materials and with creative techniques for personally engaging the client family members. The format will include lecture, video, and case study and interactive examples.

Understanding how to process

interactions will be part of the training day. Participants will have an increased ability to recognize family dynamics during Family Play Therapy activities, and will learn to select techniques based on individual family relational styles. Participants will review treatment goals for each exercise, and discuss when this method is not the treatment of choice. There will be a brief theoretical over-view of family therapy that includes a description of the theory of Family Play Therapy. (This training briefly reviews but does not teach Family Therapy theory, which is valuable

for play therapists working with two or more family members.) And there will be great practical hand-outs!!!

Note that onsite attendees will occasionally be divided into small groups to enact the experience of clients and therapist through role-playing. Those attending from around the world on iLOC, our interactive, live online classroom, may want to attend with a small group. (They can receive an additional discount this way, as well). Those attending solo on iLOC can observe a group in the classroom that is enacting the exercises.

Trudy Post Sprunk, MEd, LMFT, LPC, RPT-S is a veteran therapist, working since 1971, who has presented this seminar many times at professional conferences, and has received excellent feedback from participants. She is an RPT-S (for Assoc. for Play Therapy) as well as a family therapy supervisor (Amer. Assoc. Marriage & Family Therapy), having supervised over 300 therapists in Tucker, Georgia. She has served as the president of the Georgia Assoc. for Play Therapy numerous times and has been very active with APT including serving on the Board of Directors for six years. In 2010, Trudy collaborated with Liana Lowenstein in writing Creative Family Therapy Techniques, and has made a substantial contribution to book that is the recommended text for this Seminar.
