Book for Class: *Balance In Motion: Ivan Boszormenyi-Nagy and His Vision of Individual and Family Therapy*, opens with an illuminating interview with Boszormenyi-Nagy, which focuses on the development of CFT and highlights a number of the most valuable aspects of this approach.

An emphasis of the book is a framework for CFT that can be used when working with an individual adult, couples, any two or more family members of any age including caring about those who are dead or alive and may not even be in the session.

Theory: For the first hour of class we will discuss the theory of Contextual Therapy following the chapters of the book and applying the information to the therapists' client families. The five chapters deal with principles of loyalty, trust, and constructive and destructive entitlement. The book includes a detailed family interview conducted by Dr. Nagy that includes his own line-by-line explanation about his reasons and thinking behind each step, each question, and each intervention in the treatment. Applications in clinical practice are presented in the last chapter.

Practical Application: For the 2nd part of class, by using their own genogram, participants will apply Contextual concepts to their own families. Individually each person will identify issues and consider ways to address their own families rooted in the ethical guidelines we are studying. One option is that therapists may choose to share some of this process with the class and to invite support and concrete ideas about how to engage family members for dialogue, exoneration, and healing. (In this part of the course, therapists can choose to share or not to share and this segment will not be videotaped)

Example of possible issues in families: Addressing siblings in relationship to aging parents – medical issues, "the Will"; uncomfortable family distance or cut-offs, past or present; split loyalty, and invisible loyalty in families; unfairness issues with couples, children, parents; issues of the Family Life Cycle including raising children and young adults, mid-life crisis, medical illness, forgiveness and exoneration; the importance of ethical decision making.

Highlights: CFT 809 is a new course which uses as its text Balance In Motion: Ivan Boszormenyi-Nagy and His Vision of Individual and Family Therapy (5 Chapters, 104 pages) Published in English in 1987. This book was written with Dr. Nagy's input and was published in Holland. Dottie, the presenter became aware of it only in the last year.

- In the first and eighth classes, we will view two valuable videos of consultations with Ivan Nagy of a couple struggling with life issues and also including their three teen and young adult children.
- Classes will discuss theory and application through the reading.
- Applying CFT to one's own life is an important part of the teaching and this class offers an opportunity

to do that with support of others.

 Major concepts, including foundation of ethics & dialogue, will be woven into the class theory and practicum.

CFT Program at the FPT Center: Between 2002 and 2018, the Family Center offered a series of courses in CFT that focused on unique topics and applications for each year. Many therapists joined these courses year after year, forming a community that shared an understanding of the Contextual approach. Over the years, these members affirmed how it enriched their work. Those who have taken previous CFT courses at the Family Center or with other CFT teachers can take this course with a 25% discount. 





COURSE WITHDRAWAL & PAYMENT POLICIES

Course Withdrawal Policy for Academic Term Courses:

Academic Term Courses are courses that meet over the span of several months on a biweekly or monthly basis. Tuition is composed of (i) a deposit, which must be paid at the time of registration, and (ii) installments, which may be paid according to the schedule described in the course brochure.

- (a) If participant withdraws prior to four weeks before the first day of a course, then participant will receive a refund of the paid deposit and installments, minus a \$50 withdrawal fee.
- (b) If participant withdraws within four weeks of the first day of a course, but earlier than one week before the first day, then participant will receive a refund of paid installments and a credit in the amount of the paid deposit to be applied to future training or supervision at the center, minus a \$50 withdrawal fee.
- (c) If participant withdraws within one week before the first day of a course or on the first day of a course, then participant will receive a refund of paid installments and a credit in the amount of the paid deposit to be applied to future training or supervision at the center, minus a \$100 withdrawal fee.
- (d) Following the first day of a course, participant is committed from completing the course, and participant is responsible for payment of full yearly course tuition. Full course tuition is not reduced on account of absences; however, participant may attend missed classes with no charge during the next time that the class is offered in the recurring cycle of the curriculum.
- (e) A late fee will be assessed for past-due balances and late payments. See our payment plan brochure for details.

Course Withdrawal Policy for Short Term Courses:

Short Term Courses are courses and seminars that meet over the span of one to five contiguous days. Tuition is composed of (i) a deposit, which must be paid at the time of registration, and (ii) installments, which may be paid according to the schedule described in the course brochure.

- (a) If participant withdraws prior to four weeks before the first day of a course, then participant will receive a refund of the paid deposit and tuition, minus a \$50 withdrawal fee.
- (b) If participant withdraws within four weeks of the first day of a course, but earlier than one week before the first day, then participant will receive a refund of paid installments and a credit in the amount of the paid deposit to be applied to future training or supervision at the center, minus a \$50 withdrawal fee.
- (c) If participant withdraws within one week before the first day of a course or on the first day of a course, then participant forfeits either (i) \$150 or (ii) half of the paid deposit and installments, whichever is greater, and will receive a credit in the amount the remaining paid deposit and installments.
- (d) Following the first day of a course, participant is committed to completing the course, and participant is responsible for payment of full course tuition. Full course tuition is not reduced on account of absences.
- (e) A 1% late fee for past-due balances will be assessed at the end of each month, based on the amount past due on the last day of the month.

Payment Plan for Academic Term Courses

The Family Center offers a payment plan for Academic Term Courses. Upon registration for the course, registrant pays the deposit. The tuition balance can be paid either in 8 monthly installments starting on September 1, or in a one-time payment on September 1 (or upon registration, whichever date is later). The installment plan is charged by the Center in our administrative office and there is no extra fee for this plan.
